OSHA Pallet Jack Certification Requirements



OSHA views pallet jacks as a type of forklift, so certification is legally required.



Both hand-powered and electric pallet jacks can carry heavy loads and cause serious injuries if misused.



Certification teaches workers how to control the equipment safely and understand potential risks.



Staying compliant keeps workers safe and helps prevent OSHA violations.

Pallet Jack Inspection Requirements



OSHA requires pallet jacks to be inspected at least once every six months when used regularly.



Inspections ensure the equipment stays in good, safe working condition.



Even brand-new pallet jacks can be dangerous if not maintained or inspected properly.



Regular checks help prevent accidents caused by damaged or faulty equipment.

Pallet Jack Laws

- ✓ Employees must be certified before operating a motorized pallet jack.
- ✓ Certification must include:
 - | Formal instruction
 - | Hands-on training
 - | A performance evaluation
- ✓ Employers are legally required to provide a safe workplace, and certification helps meet that requirement.
- ✓ If OSHA finds that you skipped proper training, your company can face serious fines.
- ✓ Lack of certification can also lead to accidents. If an accident happens, OSHA will investigate the site for other safety violations.

What Are the OSHA Requirements for Pallet Jack Operators?

- | Operators must be 18 years old.
- | They must complete formal instruction online or in person.
- | They must pass an in-person evaluation to show their skills.

How Long Does Electric Pallet Jack Training Take?
